



AUDITION ANNOUNCEMENT

The Reno Philharmonic and Laura Jackson, Music Director, announce auditions for the following positions:

Section Violin & Section Viola Monday, October 18, 2021 – 6pm-10pm

Auditions will take place in the evening at Pioneer Center for the Performing Arts in Reno, NV. Face masks will be required for auditionees, as well as all onsite personnel. Auditionees will be required to provide proof of full vaccination against Covid-19.

The Reno Philharmonic offers diverse programming to the northern Nevada and eastern California region. It performs 6 pairs of Classix subscription concerts, as well as Young People's Concerts, and family and pops concerts. The Reno Philharmonic also supports four Youth Orchestras, places chamber groups in area public schools through its Discover Music program and provides after school instruction in violin and cello in three title 1 Elementary Schools.

Interested musicians must send a resume which includes phone number, address, email address, 3 references (including contact information), and proof of Covid-19 vaccination to Personnel Manager Mary Miller via email at mary.v.miller@sbcglobal.net.

After your resume has been approved, you will be sent a link to access audition materials. After the 10/8/21 deadline the candidate will be contacted by Mary to confirm that they still wish to audition, after having seen and practiced the music excerpts. Once the exact number of applicants is set the applicants will be notified of their times.

In 2021-22 section string musicians of the Reno Philharmonic will be paid \$126.68 per-service (2.5 hour) per the current Collective Bargaining Agreement. Section Violin and Viola players are guaranteed 50 services per year.
